



## IA AGILITY


- Follow the risks and strategy of the businesses as they are operating in a dynamic landscape
- Insightful, proactive, future-focused
- Promote organisation improvement
- Adapt and respond to both existing and emerging risks

### BUILDING COLLABORATIVE MODEL

- Collaborate with operational management (1<sup>st</sup> LOD) compliance and monitoring functions (2<sup>nd</sup> LOD)
- Respond to disruption with a more unified approach
- Maximize synergy by leveraging expertise and knowledge of respective teams
- Improve coordination, communication and agility in response.
- Promotes continuous efforts in organisational improvement

#### **Continuous and Predictive**



## INNOVATING INTERNAL AUDIT

- Re-think and re-invent the focus and approach of internal audit.
- Multi-disciplinary skills required to deal with strategic, business, operational and technology risks
- Technology and data-enabled.
- Leverage on the technology super-powers ("ABCD") artificial intelligence, blockchain, cloud and data analytics
- Breadth and depth of knowledge in the organisation is an engine for innovation and business improvements

## INNOVATING WITH ADVANCED DA

#### 4 types of Data Analytics



#### What is the data telling you?

#### Descriptive: What's happening in my business?

- Comprehensive, accurate and live data
- Effective visualisation

#### Diagnostic: Why is it happening?

- Ability to drill down to the root-cause
- · Ability to isolate all confounding information

#### Predictive: What's likely to happen?

- Business strategies have remained fairly consistent over time
- Historical patterns being used to predict specific outcomes using algorithms
- Decisions are automated using algorithms and technology

#### Prescriptive: What do I need to do?

- Recommended actions and strategies based on champion / challenger testing strategy outcomes
- Applying advanced analytical techniques to make specific recommendations
